



Agrelo Estate.

In this micro-climate, unique in the world, our grapes ripe slowly until reaching their full potential. Warm days and cool nights contribute to the complexity of our wines.

Location:

Agrelo, Luján de Cuyo, Mendoza, Argentina

LATITUDE: 33°16 South. LONGITUDE: 68°92 West. ALTITUDE: 1000 m above sea level.

Ecosystem.

CLIMATE: Arid, with an average rainfall starting at 200 mm/year. In the summer, temperatures are 30/35°C on average, mild during the day and cool at night. In winter, the average range is from -1.5 to 15°C, although depending on the year, temperatures may be lower than -1°C.

SOIL: It originated as a result of the disintegration of rocks in the mountains. It varies from deep clay soils to shallow rocky soils.

Plantation.

Planted in 1993, with almost 45 ha. It was finished in 1997, with 150 ha.

RED VARIETIES GROWN: Malbec - Cabernet Sauvignon - Syrah - Sangiovese - Barbera -

Petit Verdot - Pinot Noir

WHITE VARIETIES GROWN: Chardonnay - Viognier - Verdicchio

TRELLIS SYSTEMA: High espalier.

PRUNING SYSTEM: Guyot and bilateral cordon.

YIELD: 50-90 qq/ha.

DENSITY: 3500 plantas/ha: 2 m between rows and 1 m between plants.

IRRIGATION SYSTEM: Traditional by flood irrigation (melagas).
